We had an eventful week in P1/2! For our 'At the Farm' topic we planted seeds for a farmer's crop. We will watch the carrots, tomatoes, wheat, onions, peas, potatoes and corn grow over the next few weeks from the back of the classroom! The children have enjoyed tasting a selection of breads from around the world this week, commenting on texture and taste as part of our 'Bread' topic. In Literacy, we have been asking lots of questions and focusing on question words. We read the Little Red Hen, identifying questions in the story and writing our own speech bubbles for the hen, pig, cat and duck!
