2. Key Dates and Times

P1 pupils will start school on Tuesday 29th August 8:45am – 12pm. P1 – P7 pupils will be in school on Wednesday 30th August and Thursday 31st August

P2 – P7 pupils will be in school on Friday 1st September 8:45am – 2pm.

*P1 will finish at 12pm until Friday 15th September. From Monday 18th September P1 pupils will stay in school for lunch and will finish at 2pm and have the option to stay for 2-3pm and 3-5pm Clubs.

3. Arrival and Pick up Times

All pupils will start school at **8:45am**. School gates will be opened at **8:35am** for pupils to enter – parents are not permitted to walk children into the playground in the morning. School will finish at 2:00pm or 3:00pm for pupils. However, with the earlier start time of 8:45am each morning, school will finish at 2:00pm on a Friday for all pupils. Parents will collect pupils from the playground.

From Tuesday 29^{th} August – Friday 15^{th} September – <u>P1 pupils</u> can enter the school and leave the school via the P1/2 classroom fire exit door.

From Monday 18th September – P1 pupils will be encouraged to enter the school using the playground and be collected from the playground at home time.

7. Dinner Money

School dinners will be available from Friday 1^{st} September 2023. School dinners will cost £2.60 per day (£13.00 per week). Dinner menu can be found on the school website.



8. Breakfast Club

The Breakfast Club will be in the staffroom. This will be from 7:45am – 8:35am each morning. The Breakfast Club will cost $\pounds 2$ per day and will be supervised by Miss Barbour. Breakfast Club will commence on Wednesday 30th August P1-P7 pupils.

9. Break Snack

We operate a Healthy Break Policy. Our pupils are encouraged to bring a piece of fruit, vegetable or sandwich to school for their break. They are also encouraged to drink water, **fizzy drinks must not be sent to school**. Pupils can receive a break snack before they go outside at breaktime. This costs 20p and can be booked online using the SchoolMoney app. Break snack varies each day (e.g., crackers & cheese, toast, yogurt).
