

Our teacher says...

'There was great excitement on Tuesday morning when P1/2 received a letter from Rick the Ranger at Belfast Zoo, asking us if we could help find a bear that had escaped the night before. We got our wellies and set off on our very own Bear Hunt. When we got outside we followed paw prints and looked for clues telling us to go over, under, around and through lots of obstacles in the school grounds. There was great excitement when we eventually found the bear and called him Reco because we found him at the RECO box! Mrs Whiteside phoned Rick the Ranger and he came to collect him after school. As well as our Bear Hunt we have been learning about capacity and reinforcing our learning in the water tray at play time.' Miss Best (P1/2)

P3 have been learning about rounding to the nearest 10 this week. We were so good at rounding to the nearest 10 inside 100 that we progressed onto rounding to the nearest 10 inside 1000! During Literacy we looked at conjunction words to help join our sentences together. For PE, we continued our focus of invasion games, playing lots of variations of handball. ICT this week saw us learn about coding and everyone was able to type in commands to move a car around a map of Europe to help Mr Greenaway get to different holiday destinations! Some pupils even managed to move a car around a race track! We used oil pastels in art to create a rocket to the moon - you can see these displayed outside our classroom. Excellent work P3!' 'In numeracy this week we have been multiplying and dividing 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. We have also been recapping our 3D shape knowledge and their properties. In small groups we investigated which 3D shapes can roll and which can not. During literacy we spent time focusing on description using our senses. We focused on choosing descriptive words to describe popcorn, a character from our class novel and Disneyland. We recapped using capital letters for the beginning of sentences and also proper nouns which the children recalled very well. In ICT we have started to create a presentation about Ancient Egypt using Microsoft PowerPoint. Once completed, the children will present to the class. Our focus in PE has been on game play including catching and throwing the ball accurately, batting and working as a team which we implemented when playing rounders.' Miss Doyle (P4/5)

'P6/7 have been taking part in lots of fun activities related to their 'Ourselves' topic. We've been outside chalking body outlines and working as a group to label the main bones and inside the classroom we've played a memory game to help us learn the names of the teeth. In art, P6 enjoyed playing 'Roll a Picasso', where they had to roll dice and the number they got determined what they would draw. The end result being a very abstract portrait, it seems we have some very talented Picassos of our own! P7 enjoyed an excellent morning at the Bee Safe Event, learning about various aspects of safety (see the school website). Their favourite talk was definitely Kevin and his engaging session on bus safety, very useful with secondary school in the not too distant future.' Mrs Weir (P6/7)
